REDUCING HEALTHCARE INEQUALITIES

The Core20PLUS5 approach is designed to support Integrated Care Systems to drive targeted action in health inequalities improvement



 CORE20
 The most deprived 20% of the national population as identified by the Index of Multiple Deprivation

PLUS ICS-chosen population groups experiencing poorer-than-average health access, experience and/or outcomes, who may not be captured within the Core20 alone and would benefit from a tailored healthcare approach e.g. inclusion health groups

CORE20 PLUS 5

Key clinical areas of health inequalities



MATERNITY ensuring continuity

of care for 75% of women from BAME communities and from the most deprived groups



SEVERE MENTAL ILLNESS (SMI) ensuring annual health checks for 60% of those living with SMI (bringing SMI in line with the success seen in Learning Disabilities)



CHRONIC RESPIRATORY DISEASE

a clear focus on Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), driving up uptake of Covid, Flu and Pneumonia vaccines to reduce infective exacerbations and emergency hospital admissions due to those exacerbations
